



Astor's screening initiative is designed to address the current needs of students and families as they attempt to return to school, focusing on parenting stress, behavioral health, and social determinant of health barriers through a layered screening and referral program. The service is completely free for schools and families.

Program Details:

- Astor is partnering with any school-based initiatives to support outreach and engagement with students and families.
- Utilizing a team of a clinician, family peer advocate, and behavioral specialist to support students and families throughout the process.
- Offering hybrid opportunities for participation in the screening program, including phone, video, or in-person interviews.
- Using a family-driven approach to provide linkages and referrals to community and school resources.
- Providing aggregate data and feedback to schools on program impact while maintaining confidentiality for families.
- Supporting all ages, Pre-K to 12.
